In exercise of powers conferred under Rule 28 of Railway Protection Force Rules, 1987 read with Section 3 (2) of the Railway Protection Force Act, 1957 (as amended by ACT 60 of 1985) the undersigned hereby issues the following directive:-

This directive is issued in supersession of Directive No. 9 issued vide letter of even number dated 16.6.93.

Sub: Recruitment of Inspector/Pros. Gr. II and
Sub Inspector/Pros. in RPF.

1. Schedule IV of the RPF Rules, 1987 (as in directive No. 7).
2. The selection for vacancies of Inspector/Pros. Gr. II and Sub Inspector/Pros. to be filled up by promotion (as in directive No. 7).
3. As regards direct recruitment of Inspector/Pros. Grade-II and Sub Inspector/Pros. it has been decided that the recruitment to these posts will be done on All India basis by a Central Selection Board which will comprise of 2 Chief Security Commissioners, one Management Expert from Railway Board and one from Railway Staff College, Vadodara. The Board will be nominated by the Director General/RPF.
4. As regards procedure, i.e. written test, viva voce etc. (as in Directive No. 9).
