

Sub:- Timely supply of uniforms

It has been brought to my notice by members of the Staff Council during the meeting held on 16.5.96 that Uniform items in Railways are not supplied in time resulting in loss of morale, discipline and turn out of the staff. In one case no uniform item was supplied to the RPF staff over the Zonal Railway for three years due to some procurement problems.

The importance of timely supply of uniform to the RPF personnel need not be over emphasized. The members of Armed Force of the Union must always be properly dressed otherwise it gives a bad name to the Force when the public sees shabbily dressed RPF personnel. Keeping in view the importance of timely supply of uniforms of good quality to the RPF staff all over Indian Railways, it is directed that all Chief Security Commissioners must take up with the respective General Managers any delay in proper and timely supply of uniforms to the Force under their command. They should also bring to my notice such instances of delay in supply or supply of sub-standard uniform so that the matter can be taken up at the Board's level, if required. Details of this may be mentioned in their monthly D.O. to me.
