DIRECTIVE NO 25.

In supersession of the Directive No 2 (No 86/Sec (E)/PM-2/12 dated 12.07.89), the undersigned, in exercise of powers conferred under Rule 28 of Railway Protection Force Rules, 1987 (read with section 8 of the Railway Protection Force Act, 1957), hereby issues the following Directive.

Sub: - Promotion to the Non- Selection post of Head Constable.

Following guidelines are hereby detailed for conducting promotion to the non-selection 75 % posts of Head Constable on the basis of seniority subject to the rejection of unfit:-

- 1.) The rule for calling three times the number required to be empanelled shall not apply.
- 2.) Calculation of vacancies shall be done as per Rule 70.4 of RPF Rules 1987.
- 3.) In terms of RPF Rules 1987, a panel shall be drawn from among the Constables securing 60% (12 marks) out of 20 in order of their seniority. The assessment shall be based on ACRs for the last 5 years and the marks be given as under:-

Outstanding	- 4 marks for each year
Very Good	- 3.5 marks for each year
Good	- 3 marks for each year
Average	- 2.5 marks for each year
Below Average	- No marks



The inter-se seniority of the successful candidates empanelled against 75% (Non-selection) vis-à-vis 25%(selection u/r 72) shall be determined in following order:-

1	75 % (non-selection)	Firstly candidates selected against existing vacancies
2	25% (selection u/r 72)	Below (1), Candidates selected against existing vacancies
3	75% (non-selection)	Below (2), first three candidates selected against anticipated vacancies
4	25% (selection u/r 72)	Below (3), 4 th candidate selected against anticipated vacancy.
5		To be continued in the order of 3 and 4.

4.) This Directive will come into force with immediate effect.
