**Sub. Repair/Maintenance of RPF Barracks over Indian Railways-
Projection of additional requirement of fund under Demand no. 4**

Your attention is drawn towards a tragic incident of collapse of one building, housing GRP as well as Parcel Office, on 08.02.2016, which was situated near PRS Center at Railway Station, Hubli. Seven persons are reported dead and 16 persons are reported injured, as a result of above building collapse. Karnataka Police has also registered a criminal case against Railway Establishment for negligence, leading to the collapse/accident.

It is a tragic incident which might have been avoided, if corrective measures, by way of timely repair of these offices, had been taken. This is a wake-up call, which needs to be seriously taken to avoid recurrence of such incidences in future.

Issue regarding repair/maintenance of barracks has been deliberated in Boards office and it has been clarified to FA&CAO of All Indian Railways that expenditure on repair and maintenance of RPF barracks is to be booked under Demand No. 4 (Sub-head 410). (Copy enclosed)

It is requested that suitable instructions be given to the concerned officials to ensure projection of additional requirement of fund for repairs and maintenance of barracks under Demand No. 4 (Sub head 410), in the budget estimates of year 2016-17, so that repair and maintenance of RPF Barracks may be ensured to improve living condition of RPF personnel.


