

Railway Protection Special Force.

1. **Brief History:**

During China aggression of 1962, it was considered necessary to maintain the communication lifeline of Railways for transportation of men and materials to the front and relieve the Army. For this purpose, it was decided to raise 04 Battalions immediately extracting suitable men and officers from the existing RPF Armed Wing on Railways. Thereafter many more Battalions were also raised and as of now there are total 15 BNs in RPSF including 01 Commando and 01 Mahila BN.

2. **Salient features:**

RPSF is the specialized Armed Wing of RPF and is, therefore, required to act as a Striking Force and as a back-up for the RPF in facing serious problems of Railway Crime, Anti-Social Elements, Agitation, Terrorism, Insurgency etc. affecting the operations of Railways.

B. Training Centre:

1. Brief History:

In the year 1964, a training cell started functioning at 2nd BN/RPSF Gorakhpur to run various in-service training courses. It was upgraded as formal Training Centre in the year 1999 and its status was reiterated as recognised Training Centre for RPSF in the year 2003. In order to streamline the activities of Training Centre at par with other Zonal Training Centers of RPF, its administrative control was reinforced with Commanding Officer 2BN/RPSF in the year 2007. Further, in the year 2009, Director JR RPF Academy/ LKO was designated for mentoring and to exercise the general supervision over Training Centre for formulating training syllabus, curriculum transaction and evaluation of ongoing training activities of different in-service and basic courses.

2. Salient features:

More than 20,000 RPF/RPSF personnel have been trained in the Training Centre through various initial and in-service courses. 49 Batches of Constable initial/ repeater training course, 34 batches of Head Constable Promotion Course, 09 batches of SI & 18 batches of ASI promotion course, 35 batches of Grenade Induction Course, 14 batches of CTI course, 66 batches of Weapon and tactics course and 40 batches of computer course have successfully been organised so far.

As an average, more than 1000 RPF/RPSF personnel get trained every year in this training centre. Constabulary Training Instructor (CTI) Course has been an iconic course of this training centre. In order to give due recognition to it, Hon'ble DG/RPF, on 26 Jan, 2019, has unveiled an esthetically designed rectangular shaped Pocket Badge to be worn by the successful graduates of the CTI Courses of this Centre.
