

**Jeevan Rakshak Padak**

1	CT	NCR	Gyan Chand	Late Shri Gyan Chand, Head Constable RPF, North Central Railway, while on duty as Rojnamcha writer on 2 nd May 2021 at about 11.41 PM on Bharwari station, saw a lady standing on the track in the face of approaching Prayagraj – Jaipur express with intention to commit suicide. Sh Gyan Chand alerted the lady, but she did not move away from track. On seeing this, Sh Gyan Chand sprinted towards the lady and pushed her to safety in the nick of time. However, he could not get out of the harm's way and was hit by the running train and laid down his life on the altar of duty.	
2	CT	ER	Dinker Tiwari	On 08.03.2021 a massive fire broke out in the 13th floor of New Koilaghat Buiding situated at 14 Strand Road, Kolkata in which several people were trapped due to heat and smoke. Seeing this Constable Dinker Tiwari while displaying tremendous courage not only helped in extinguishing the fire but also rescued three persons trapped in the building, thereby displaying exemplary valour at the cost of his own life and safety. In recognition of this act, he has been awarded Jeevan Raksha Padak by the President of India.	
3	CT	ER	Tridip Paul	On 08.03.2021 a massive fire broke out in the 13th floor of New Koilaghat Buiding situated at 14 Strand Road, Kolkata in which several people were trapped due to heat and smoke. Seeing this Constable Tridip Paul while displaying tremendous courage not only helped in extinguishing the fire but also rescued three persons trapped in the building, thereby displaying exemplary valour at the cost of his own life and safety. In recognition of this act, he has been awarded Jeevan Raksha Padak by the President of India.	
4	CT	NR	Rajbir Singh	On 23.07.2021 at 22:42 hrs, a passenger of train No. 04379 slipped and his leg got stuck between train & platform while he was trying to board a moving train. On duty RPF Constable Shri Rajbir Singh ran towards this passenger immediately and pulled him safely away from the moving train and in the process he also sustained injuries. By keeping himself calm while handling this critical situation, Constable Rajbir Singh was able to save a precious life at the cost of danger to his own life. In recognition of this act, he has been awarded Jeevan Raksha Padak by the President of India.	

5	CT	SER	Sanjeet Kumar Ram,	<p>On 20.07.2021, at Bishnupur Railway Station one person jumped on the track with the motive to commit suicide in front of the approaching train, and when the train was 100 mtrs away HC/Sanjeet Kumar Ram noticed the person. He immediately rushed toward the spot and pulled him away from Railway track without caring for his own life thereby saving the life of person who was going to commit suicide.</p> <p>In recognition of this act, he has been awarded Jeevan Raksha Padak by the President of India.</p>	
6	CT	SER.	Bongu Narasimha Rao	<p>On 12.02.2021, at Bankura Railway Station one person jumped on the track with the motive to commit suicide in front of the approaching train no- 08027 (ASN-KGP Pgr.). CT/Bongu Narasimha Rao noticed the person and he immediately rushed toward the spot and pulled him away from Railway track without caring for his own life thereby saving the life of person who was going to commit suicide.</p> <p>In recognition of this act, he has been awarded Jeevan Raksha Padak by the President of India.</p>	
7	ASC	NR	Gurjasbir Singh	<p>During his 28 years of service, Shri Gurjasbir Singh has distinguished himself with exceptional meritorious service in RPF. He played a vital role in the arrest of dreaded terrorist Balbir Singh who opened fire at Ludhiana Railway station killing one vendor and injuring 02 police personnel. For this act, Hon'ble President of India conferred upon him Jeevan Raksha Medal, 2010. A highly decorated officer he has shown great courage and management skills during his tenure as ASC Qazigund in the disturbed areas of Anantnag, Pulwama and Kulgam of Kashmir valley.</p>	
8	CT	SWR	Shri S. M. Rafi	<p>On 21.12.2019, Shri S.M. Rafi while performing duty at Bellary railway station saw a women passenger fall down into the gap between the train and the platform while trying to board a moving train No.11304. Shri Rafi leapt towards her and pulled her out of the gap alongside the moving train while displaying commendable alertness and courage</p>	

9	CT	WCR	Shri Mukesh Chaudhary	On 23.07.2019 Shri Mukesh Choudhary while performing duty at Dara station noticed that a passenger along with his 3 kids was trying to board running train No.69156 and then suddenly his 3 year old daughter slipped and fell down in the gap between rail line and platform. Risking his own life, Shri Mukesh laid down on the platform and held on to the child stuck in the gap and safely pulled out the child.	
10	CT	WR	Shri Vani Hiren Kumar	On 24.08.2019, Shri Vani Hiren Kumar while deployed at Bharuch station noticed that a lady along with her 2-month-old baby was trying to board the Train No. 69150 which had started. The lady passenger fell down but kept on hanging from the coach while holding onto the handle. Shri Hiren Kumar ran alongside and pulled the lady away from the coach thereby saving life of women and child while posing great danger to his life.	
11	CT	WR	Shri Ravindra Kumar	On 17.08.2019, Shri Ravindra Kumar while performing train passing duty at LC Gate No. 158 B noticed that some people were crossing the track even when the level crossing gate was closed for the passage of a goods train. When a container goods train was approaching towards the LC gate, 2 females were crossing the track to the other side. On spotting the 2 ladies Shri Kumar ran towards them and pulled them away from the track while putting his own life in danger.	
12	CT	SR	Shri S. V. Jose	On 1.06.2019 Shri S.V. Jose while on duty at Chennai Egmore Station saw a person along with his daughter running towards the moving train No. 16865 to board the train but the daughter lost her balance and fell into the gap between the train and the platform. On the seeing the young girl fall, Shri S.V.Jose acted swiftly and pulled her out of the gap while risking his own life.	
13	CT	WCR	Shri Ram Raja Yadav	On 28.07.2018 Shri Ramraja Yadav while performing seal checking duty at Katni station found that a lady passenger while trying to board a running train No. 13201 lost her balance and fell into the gap between platform and running train. Showing exemplary presence of mind and courage Shri Yadav while putting his own life in danger rushed towards the lady and pulled her up to the platform.	

14	CT	WR	Shri Shivcharan Singh	On 10.08.2019, Shri Shivcharan Singh while performing train escorting duty on Train No. 12959 noticed some persons trapped in heavy flood, shouting for help, when the train stopped due to waterlogging on the tracks near Shymkhayali railway station. Shri Shivcharan Singh, without caring for his own life, rushed to their rescue and saved precious lives of 09 persons.	
15	HC	NWR	Shri Mukesh Kumar Meena	Shri Mukesh Kumar Meena, Head Constable/RPF/Jodhpur division, while on train escorting duty on 16.09.2018 in Train No. 22478, displayed exemplary courage in saving the life of a lady passenger along with 02 children. Shri Mukesh Meena jumped from the running train and pulled out the lady passenger from the gap between the platform and the train along with both her children.	
16	CT	NR	Late Jagbir Singh Rana	Late Shri Jagbir Singh laid down his life on duty while saving precious lives of 4 children on railway premises near Adarshnagar-Azadpur railway section, Delhi. Displaying unmatched valour, he went beyond the call of his duty and without caring for his own life saved the lives of these children.	
17	CT	CR	Anil Kumar	Shri Anil Kumar, Constable, Railway Protection Force of Mumbai Division/Central Railway, while deputed for prevention and detection of passenger belonging theft at Thane Station on 03/12/2019 at about 22.29 hrs, noticed one person struggling to get onto the platform no. 7 from the track while train No. 18029 was approaching and had come perilously close. Shri Anil Kumar, who was on Platform no. 6, seeing imminent danger to life of the person, jumped to the track, acted swiftly, lifted the person within fraction of second and saved him by putting him out of the harm's way without caring for his own life. Due to timely and courageous action, he was able to save valuable life of a person.
