
**Sub:- Procedure regarding closure of Special Occurrence Report (SOR) case files.**

\*\*\*\*\*

Special Occurrence Reports are issued by the Divisions as per provision given under rule 230 of the RPF Rules, 1987. Most of the SORs are related to offences registered under the Indian Penal Code. Such cases remain under trial in various courts for a long period after submission of charge-sheet by the investigating agency. Due to this, case files of SORs remain pending at Board, Zonal and Divisional levels awaiting final outcome from Courts. After inclusion of cases of thefts of passengers' belongings (TOPB), the volume of SORs have further increased.

It has been decided that the files of SOR cases, wherein Charge-Sheets/Final Reports have been filed in the Courts, may be closed and a closure report may be sent to the Security Directorate for closing such files at Railway Board.
