

Sub: Transfer of RPF/RPSF Personnel.

In continuation of Standing Order No.2, 1996 issued vide this office letter of even number dated 22.5.96, it is advised that the requests of Inter Railway Transfer will not be submitted to DG's office as and when received from RPF Personnel but will be submitted in one lot every year by 31st January. The requests of Inter Railway Transfers will be processed in DG's office during March every year and order will be issued by April coinciding with the academic session.

While furnishing the requests of Inter Railway Transfer, CSCs will see that RPF Personnel seeking transfer has an unblemished record of service and no DAR case is pending against him and he has completed 10 years service on the Railway where he was first appointed and he has submitted undertaking to go on bottom seniority.
