Standing Order No.80

In supersession of order No.2001/Sec(ABE)/PM/3/4 dated 12.06.2006 the following orders are issued regarding the stay of Asstt. Comdts. of RPSF with their respective companies.

1. The Asstt.Comdts. of RPSF Coys will stay in their coys whenever the coy is deployed outside the Bn/Hq. for the purpose of proper supervision, command and control, discipline, fitness, proper briefing of troops, detailing of duties and speedy redressal of grievances at the place of deployment.
2. That such stay by the Asstt Comdts. in the Coy will be for a period of minimum 18 night halts. A night halt would mean a stay in the coy from 20.00 Hrs\* on a date to 06.00 Hrs the following day.
3. In order to ensure that the ~~work~~ ~~of~~ the coy at Battalion Headquarters does not suffer during the absence of the Asstt. Comdt from Battalion headquarters while on tour of his company, the dealing ~~clerk~~ ~~of~~ the coy, which is deployed outside the Bn/Hq. may accompany the Asstt. Comdt. of the company during tours. This will ensure that both the Asstt. Comdt. and dealing ~~clerk~~ ~~are~~ at one place at a given time.
4. The Sr.DSCs/DSCs under whose jurisdiction the RPSF coys are deployed will ensure proper accommodation as per ~~order~~ ~~for~~ the Asstt.Comdts. of the RPSF coys.
5. It will be strictly checked by the DIG Ops-I, DIG Ops-II & Sr.CO's/COs and reflected by them in their monthly diaries. Any ~~shortfall~~ ~~in~~ stay in the coy on the part of the Asstt. Comdt. concerned should be ~~re~~ ~~communicated~~ in writing to Railway Board with copy to DIG Ops-I & II, which will also form the basis of the annual report regarding operational preparedness on part of the ~~AC~~ ~~concerned~~.

These orders should be implemented both in letter & spirit with immediate effect.
