

1. Brief History:-

The Unit was established in 1985 and is a coach manufacturing unit of Indian Railways, spread over an area of 1178 acres. The total area of 1178 acres comprises of Workshop area spread over 340 acres and Township area spread over 838 acres. RCF is 3.3 km lengthwise parallel to the railway line and 1.4 km wide. The perimeter of RCF is 6.93 kms. There are 3920 railway quarters in RCF township. The Factory has 59 shops, in which 5798 employees work. RCF is manufacturing of all five types of new style coaches viz. Tejas, Humsafar, UDAY, Antyodaya and Deendayal.

2. Silent Features:-

The entire area has been declared as a Protected Area vide Notification No. 97-120/LFA dated 23.02.1987 and any trespassers can be prosecuted under Railways Act. There is a paved road for patrolling alongwith the boundary wall. There are only two entry/exit gates to enter RCF. A new underpass has been commissioned on 20.11.21 in lieu of one of these gates. There are 48 CCTV cameras installed at the entrances gates, shopping complex etc. in RCF and 55 CCTV are installed in the shops of different departments located in the workshop area, RPF is also using 6 bicycles for patrolling in RCF. Drone camera is used for surveillance. Watch towers are available for surveillance.
