DIRECTIVE NO. 7

In exercise of powers conferred under Rule 28 of Railway Protection Force Rules, 1987 read with section 8(2) of the Railway Protection Force Act, 1957 (as amended by Act 60 of 1985), the undersigned hereby issues the following directive:

Sub: Recruitment of Inspector(Prosecution) Grade-II and Sub-Inspector(Prosecution) in RPF.

Schedule IV of the RPF Rules, 1987 provides for the method of recruitment for the posts of Inspector(Prosecution) Grade-II and Sub-Inspector (Prosecution) which are to be filled up through direct recruitment and by promotion to the extent of the percentage fixed for each group.

The selection for vacancies of Inspector (Pros.) Grade-II meant to be filled up by promotion be done by the Zonal Railways as provided in the Schedule IV of RPF Rules, 1987. As regards selection for vacancies of Sub-Inspector(Pros.) meant to be filled up by promotion, it has been decided that these posts will be filled up by a Central Selection Committee to be nominated by Director General/RPF comprising of three Divisional Security Commissioners taking into account the vacancies of the Sub-Inspector(Pros.) on all the Railways together and these will be filled up from amongst law graduates working in the RPF/RPSF.

As regards direct recruitment of Inspector(Pros.) Grade-II and Sub-Inspector(Pros.), it has been decided that the recruitment to these posts will be done on an All India basis by a Central Selection Board which will comprise of three Chief Security Commissioners of Zonal Railways and a Superior Officer of the Prosecution Branch. The Board will be nominated by the Director General/RPF. There will be no written test for such direct recruitment of Inspector(Pros.) Grade-II and Sub-Inspector(Pros.) but only viva voce. 60% marks will be allotted for

Academic record and 40% for Viva Voce. Out of total marks minimum pass marks would be 60%. Detailed guidelines for selections would be issued separately for Central Selection Board.

Sub: Recruitment of APP(Sub Inspector Prosecution) under Rule 72.

In continuation to the Directive No.7 circulated vide letter of even no. dated 26.8.92, further guidelines for the Selection to the post of SI Prosc.(APP) (meant to be filled up by promotion by the Central Selection Committee) are hereby prescribed:


Allocation of marks for written examination , practical and viva-voce tests:

	<u>Maximum Marks</u>	<u>Qualifying Marks</u>
a) Written Examination to test the knowledge in RPF Act/Rules, Railways Act , RP(UP)Act, and major criminal laws.	40	
b) Practical test including IT & PT	20	36

Candidates qualifying in the above test shall be subject to viva voce test for which maximum marks shall be awarded as under:

a) Viva voce to test the knowledge of laws on related issues.	20
b) Record of Service	20

The Committee may draw a panel amongst the candidates securing sixty-percent marks or more in the order of merit and submit the proceedings of the Selection to DG RPF for approval and allocation of the Railway to successful candidates.
