In exercise of powers conferred under Rule 28 of Railway Protection Force Rules, 1987 read with Section 8 of the Railway Protection Force Act, 1957, the Director General hereby issues the following directive:

D I R E C T I V E NO.11

Sub: Dress regulation - revision of buttons, cap and shoulder badges issued to other ranks.

.....

Some Zonal Railways have represented that the Brass buttons, cap and shoulder badges issued to the RPF Staff from the rank of Head Constable to Constable are not presenting a proper look and appearance and they may be replaced with white metal which will give a smart appearance.

After careful examination it has been decided that in future all new issues of buttons, cap badges and shoulder badges will be of white metal for all ranks. The existing stock must be consumed while placing fresh indents. The Dress Regulation may be treated as amended to this extent.

The directive will come into force with immediate effect.
